



BHWT Children's Code of Conduct

Please read this with the children before each BHWT workshop. You may do this a few days before the workshop is due to take place.

There will be live animals visiting us. As a group, we need to:

1. Always listen to what the speaker tells us.
2. Be quiet and talk quietly when around the hens.
3. Give the hens plenty of space and don't crowd them so that they don't feel scared.
4. Move sensibly around the class and not make sudden movements.
5. Wash our hands after meeting the hens.
6. Only touch the hens if the owner has told us to do so.
7. Only feed the hens if the owner has told us to do so.
8. If we would to clap at the end of the talk, then we must do it very quietly as it may startle the hens.
9. If we are not sensible around the hens, the speaker may have to take them away.
