| When: | Rehomings typically take place approximately 8 - 10 times per year and usually at a weekend. |
| Main Duties: | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To provide a site for members of the public to visit to collect their hens on a rehoming day.• To make available a <u>secure</u> area e.g. stables or barns for holding of hens on the day.• To provide parking space for 15 - 20 cars• To maintain and uphold the good name and reputation of the charity and are conversant with our aims.• To co-operate and communicate with members of BHWT staff, volunteers and rehomers.• To respect the need for confidentiality in relation to restricted charity information. |
